Level 2 Certificate in Allergy Awareness for those working in Adult Health and Social Care

Course Content

The course is suitable for a wide range of learners who wish to develop their knowledge and understanding of allergies. It may be useful as an introduction for those who wish to pursue a career in working with people who have allergies, or those preparing for a wide range of job roles in diverse sectors which require them to have an awareness of allergies as part of their responsibilities.

To be awarded this qualification, learners must successfully complete the **3** mandatory units listed below

After your induction you will receive your learning resource/information pack which includes 2 assessments covering the following units:

Unit 1: Allergens, allergies and intolerances

Unit 2: Food labelling and packaging

Unit 3: Allergy awareness for those working in adult health and social care

Completing the Course

The Certificate consists of two assessments normally taking up to four weeks per assessment so there is no need to attend a college to gain the qualification. The learning materials contain the knowledge needed to meet the assessment requirements of the course and activities allow you to practice your skills and test your learning. Assessment is based on a combination of knowledge and skills learned on the programme.

You must complete all two assessments, within the agreed timescales and submit these for marking by our team of qualified tutors.

Your tutor will provide feedback, advice and guidance to ensure you can complete the course. Upon successful completion of all three assessments you will be awarded the Level 2 Certificate in Allergy Awareness for those working in Adult Health and Social Care

Course Costs
